Principles

- We will ensure the Restoration and Renewal Delivery Authority has the resources it needs to deliver high standards of HSW effectively and without compromise.
- We will foster a "Just Culture" of fairness, inclusion, collaboration and respect which will underpin the way we work.
- Our people are key to our success. We will create effective lines of communication and engagement to put them at the heart of our solutions. Everybody will receive the training and skills they need to be effective in their work.
- We will ensure health, mental health and wellbeing have parity in importance to safety. Our people will be given the knowledge and opportunity to leave the project healthier than when they joined.
- We will engage with our stakeholders positively to embrace each other's principles. We will support their efforts at all times to foster a one programme approach to HSW.

Applicability, Implementation, Improvement and Resources

This Policy applies to all aspects of the work of the Sponsor Body. Implementation of this policy will be achieved primarily by utilising joint arrangements such as the management system processes and procedures of the Restoration and Renewal Delivery Authority's Integrated Management System. Where Sponsor Body specific arrangements are required, these will be developed in line with current best practice within the industry.
